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About BYB	The Be Your Best (BYB) Summer College Prep Academy is a free program for teens and young adults between the ages of 16 and 22. At Be Your Best, students have the opportunity to prepare for college by taking pre-college Math, Reading, and Writing. Students receive guidance and support through dedicated instructors, advisors, counselors and tutors. Students will also benefit from the educational seminars designed for college success and participate in leadership, volunteer, and educational activities and field trips throughout the summer.												
Tutor description	<p>Be Your Best (BYB) tutors will lead individual or group tutoring sessions. Tutors will help students improve their comprehension of the specific course content by modeling various study strategies and effective approaches. Tutors are proactive and responsive to the student's needs and may schedule additional tutoring time as needed. Tutors maintain records of sessions and provide progress and status reports to the supervisor. Tutors are required to complete a computerized training session and additional training from professional staff during BYB and prior to the beginning of the program. Tutors also participate and assist in bi-weekly seminars and special events such as the BYB Orientation & Graduation and in organizing fun activities and field trips throughout the summer.</p> <p>“Driving Tutors” Some tutors may gain additional hours by providing rides for participants to and from Riverland campus using a Riverland state vehicle. The tutor must have a valid driver's license, auto insurance and go through a background check to be eligible.</p>												

Position Qualifications:

Required:

- At least 18 years of age or will be by the start of the program (June 11, 2017).
- Self-directed/ability to work independently
- Knowledge and ability to work with students that are different from your own culture/traditions
- Experience that demonstrates critical thinking, problem solving and outstanding leadership skills
- Have earned at least a B+ in college-level English and/or Math (i.e. Freshman English/College Algebra)
- Have completed at least 12 credits of college level work at a college or university setting
- Availability Mondays - Thursdays from 8 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (for specific times see application)
- Availability for 3-4 evenings throughout the summer for special events given one week's notice
- Availability to attend 10-hours of tutor training prior to June 11, 2017 (dates to be determined)

Preferred:

- Have a valid driver's license and auto insurance and be willing to work additional hours to provide rides for participants using a Riverland state vehicle
- Have prior experience with the Be Your Best Program (past participant/tutor or volunteer)
- A current Riverland Student or Riverland Alumni
- Have prior experience with tutoring Math and/or English
- A first-generation college student (your parents did not complete a bachelor's degree)
- A member of a racial/ethnic minority (African, American Indian, Asian, Hispanic etc.)
